## Michael S. Dukakis Aquatics Center Operating Rules for Safety

### Family Swim Day

- NO RUNNING – at no time is running permitted anywhere in the aquatics center. This includes hallways, locker rooms, and pool deck.
- NO DIVING – Diving of any sort is strictly prohibited.
- NO FOOD OR DRINK – food and beverages are prohibited in the locker rooms, the pool deck and pool. HEALTH CONSENT – Swimmers are not experiencing any of the following:
  1. Fever – body temperature greater than or equal to 99.0 degrees Fahrenheit
  2. Vomiting in last two days
  3. Colds or respiratory infections including coughing
  4. Rashes or any open areas to the skin
  5. Ear and/or eye infections
  6. Nasal infections or discharge
  7. Diarrhea present during the last 2 weeks
  8. Any contagious diseases and/or infections
  9. Female students experiencing menses any time during the previous two days
- NO SWIMMING WITHOUT A LIFEGUARD PRESENT - Lifeguard shall be on duty at all times that NECC® students are using the pool. Lifeguard ratio is set at 1 guard per every 25 persons. This ratio includes persons on the pool deck and those in the water.
- LIFEGUARD - Lifeguard shall be identified by official guard swimwear at all times.
- SHOWERS - All swimmers must take a cleansing shower with soap, before and after swimming.
- TOILETING - All students must use the restroom prior to swimming.
- SUPERVISION - One parent must be in the pool within 5 feet of NECC student at all times. Parents must be able to effectively supervise siblings.
- SWIM DIAPERS - Young children must wear swim diapers. NECC will provide.
- Parents must provide bathing suits. NECC will provide extra towels.
